



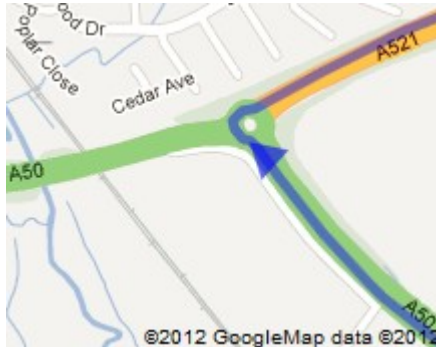
directions from the south-east

1. Take the M1 northbound.

2. At J24 take the A50 westbound towards Stoke and Derby, going left (2nd exit) at the roundabout at the top of the slip road.



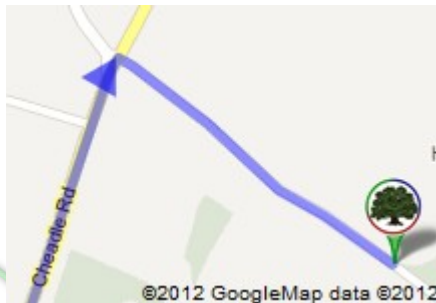
3. Continue along the A50 for ~45 miles, going straight over 3 roundabouts. At the 4th roundabout, the A50 makes a right angle turn to the left. Take the only other exit, to the right, signposted for Cheadle, Blythe Bridge and Upper Tean. This will bring you into Draycott-in-the-Moors.



4. Continue ~1.5 miles through Draycott until you reach the Draycott Arms pub on the left. Turn left immediately before the pub, into Cheadle Road.



5. Go up the hill for ~1 mile until you reach the first right-hand turning, which is at a small, unmarked crossroads. Just to the left of the entrance to the turning you will see a sign for Huntley Wood. Turn right here, into Coneygreaves lane.



6. Continue ~1/3 of a mile down Coneygreaves Lane until you reach a set of large palisade gates, almost directly in front of you. This is Huntley Wood, and is clearly marked.
