



directions from the south-west

1. Take the M6 northbound.

2.



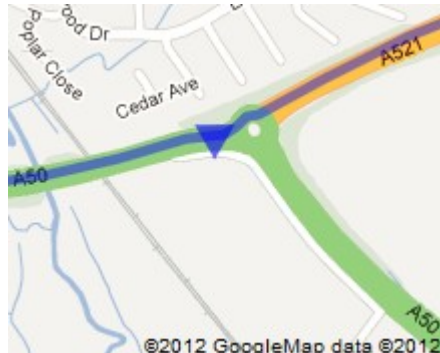
At J15 take the A500 eastbound towards Stoke and Newcastle-under-lyme, going straight over the roundabout at the top of the slip road.

3.



After ~2 miles, take the A50 east towards Uttoxeter and Derby, turning right at the roundabout at the top of the slip road. On the slip road, be careful to stay to the right and not to take the left-hand fork towards Campbell road.

4.



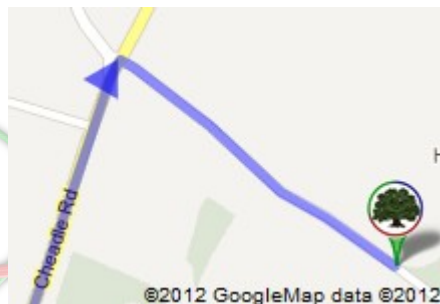
Continue along the A50 for ~6 miles. At the first roundabout, the A50 makes a right-angled turn to the right. Take the only other exit, which goes straight on, signposted for Cheadle, Blythe Bridge and Upper Tean.

5.



Continue ~1.5 miles through Draycott until you reach the Draycott Arms pub on the left. Turn left immediately before the pub, into Cheadle Road.

6.



Go up the hill for ~1 mile until you reach the first right-hand turning, which is at a small, unmarked crossroads. Just to the left of the entrance to the turning you will see a sign for Huntley Wood. Turn right here, into Coneygreaves lane.

7. Continue ~1/3 of a mile down Coneygreaves Lane until you reach a set of large palisade gates, almost directly in front of you. This is Huntley Wood, and is clearly marked.
